You said your priority was:	Anti social behaviour in Gas Works, Central, Etnam St, Spar Car parks. Vehicles congregating within the car parks, causing anti social behaviour and leaving litter.
Date set: Date completed:	01/08/2014 01/06/2016
We undertook:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High visibility patrols by the safer neighbourhood team with a view to disrupting this behaviour, identifying persons responsible and dealing with them accordingly. • Several council exclusion letters from the car parks have been served on drivers, conducting the above behaviour. • Update 08/02/2017 • No further problems to report at present. The Team will however continue to undertake patrols of areas listed.
You said your priority was:	Anti Social Behaviour and Criminal Damage to properties on the Barons Cross Estate, Leominster
Date set:	01/10/2014
We have undertaken:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • High visibility patrols conducted by the Safer Neighbourhood Team. • House to House surveys conducted by the Safer Neighbourhood Team in the area. <p>Update 08/02/2017</p> <p>Patrols are continuing in areas of concern. The SNT are continuing to deal robustly with Offenders identified causing Anti Social Behaviour and Criminal Damage on the Barons Cross Estate. A number of warning letters have been served on youths identified.</p>
You said your priority was:	Anti Social Behaviour, Criminal damage and reports of drug use in The Grange, Etnam Street Car Park, Sydonia and The Priory with surrounding areas.
Date set:	01/02/2017
We have undertaken:	High visibility patrols targetted in those areas by the SNT.

The West Mercia Police area and especially North Herefordshire remains low crime. That said a number of incidents have occurred during the month and I would ask you to have a look at these to see if you could help with any information which may assist us in bringing the offenders to justice. Criminal damage – Damage was caused to a vehicle parked in Church Street sometime between 18:45 on 23/01/2017 and 12:00 on 27/01/2017. *Incident 251S 270117.*

Burglary – A garage at an unoccupied property in Godiva Road was broken into sometime between 20/01/2017 and 24/01/2017. A quantity of tools were stolen from within. *Incident 462S 240117.*

Criminal damage – A vehicle parked in Cranes Lane was damaged at around 11:35 on 21/01/2017. A group of youths were seen leaving the area at around this time. This group may not be connected with this incident but if you saw anything at this time in Cranes Lane please contact Police and quote incident 235S 210117.

Criminal damage – A vehicle parked at the public car park close to the Priory was damaged sometime between 15/01/2017 and 18/01/2017. *Incident 579S 180117.*

Burglaries – 2 properties in Radnor View have been broken into. Both properties were unoccupied at the time and the burglaries are believed to have occurred around 16/01/2017. Entry was gained at the rear of each property, which are located a short distance from each other. A quantity of cash and jewellery was stolen from these properties. Please be aware that any information provided within this newsletter is to inform you of incidents of note and to request possible assistance. We do not wish to worry you in anyway.
